cc350 General Information

First off, thank you for registering and being part of this event! Money raised from your efforts will support 'green' initiatives at Claremont Secondary School, specifically the construction of a dry and secure compound for kids and staff to store their bikes and skateboards. We believe with the addition of this compound, a greater portion of our school's population will skate/ride to school.

With your team of 5 you will be biking 350 laps around Claremont Secondary's school track on May 10th. This will be completed in a relay style, meaning that only one team member will be biking at a time. The laps can be split up between you and your team any way you would like (ex. teams can switch riders every 10 laps, have each member complete their 70 laps in one go or even have some riders do more laps than others). To track each team's progress chip timing technology will be attached to each team's bike. If you cannot bring your own bike, please let us know so we can make other arrangements. You must bring your own helmet!

The cost to register a team is \$50 (\$10 per person), which you can bring to the event (cash or cheque, cheques to be made out to SD63 with memo: "cc350"). Included in this package is a sponsor sheet and canvassing information sheet, we encourage you to ask family or friends to support your efforts! Additional sponsor sheets can be printed off the cc350 website if needed. Please put all of your team's sponsor sheets and collected money in one envelope labeled with team name and amount raised. There are AMAZING prizes for the team who fundraises the most money!

All teams are asked to be at Claremont Secondary School (directions are posted on website) on Friday, May 10th no later than 8:45am (we need to sign you in and get you set up with the chip timing technology). Additional parking for riders will be by the tennis courts behind Claremont Secondary (see the Google map on website). There will be a registration table where you will confirm your arrival, hand in the registration fee, waiver and media release forms and the sponsor sheets and money. Please have these ready when you come to the table. The race will begin just before 9:10am and all teams should be finished by 3:30pm (some teams will be finished earlier than others). There will be an area near the track for riders to keep their bags; this is also where team member will change over their riders.

Refreshments and light snacks will be provided for all riders. Also, there will be food vendors there on the day from which you can purchase lunch (or bring your own). It would be a good idea to bring cash with you on this day, as the vendors may not accept interact or credit.

In addition to most money raised, there will also be fantastic prizes for the team who finishes the 350 laps the fastest (we will have a lap counter for your team,) and for the team with the most spirit. We had some crazy costumes last year so don't be afraid to come dressed up!

What?

On May 10th of this year Claremont Secondary's Institute for Global Solutions program is running its fourth annual "cc350" (climate change 350) where participants will ride bikes 350 times around the school track in teams of five for **a total of 140km!** This event is organized by high school students in an effort to raise money to promote 'green' initiatives at Claremont Secondary.

Where is my money going?

At the beginning of the 2010 school year a group of hardworking environmentally conscious teens applied for a grant for photovoltaic solar panels from SolarBC's Solar for Schools program, their application was successful and the 2.5kw system is now installed and running on the roof of our school! Winning this \$20,000 grant was a huge feat, but between what the grant covers and the installation of such a system there was a \$5,000 shortfall, which was raised by this event in May of 2010 and 2011. This year, we are planning on creating a 'bicycle compound' where students and staff can store their bikes in a safe, dry location. We feel that if this goal is achieved, this year's cc350 will be a significant step towards the eventual goal of becoming a carbon neutral learning environment.
